

People invited to dig in as part of archaeology project

People in Southwold and Reydon are being invited to dig a test pit at their homes to find out how the area has developed over hundreds of years.

Experts from Cambridge University will be on hand to help those taking part and to identify and date their discoveries as part of the Dig for the Past initiative between August 28-31.

Southwold Museum and Historical Society has joined forces with Access Cambridge Archeology to launch the project, which is also being supported by the Touching the Tide scheme.

It is being led by Dr Carenza Lewis, known for the BBC's *Story of England* and *The Great British Story*, and Channel 4's *Time Team*.
